The 1991 Prague Quadriennale, the international theatre design exhibition and competition, will be the first to be organised under the new political regime in Czechoslovakia. The heavy subsidy it enjoyed in the past is now less secure, so all concerned with its future hope that it will be successful and well supported. It will take place at the Palace of Culture in Prague from June 10 - 30.

Under the auspices of the Society of British Theatre Designers, arrangements are being made to mount a British entry of set and costume designs and there are also plans to organise a "supporters' club" one week trip to Prague, leaving London on June 8 and returning on June 15. Members joining this visit will be able to attend the various functions which surround the PQ - the Awards ceremony, receptions and the OISTAT mini Conference, which is taking place on June 13. The Conference theme will be *Performing Mozart Today*. In addition, there will be plenty of opportunity to look round this most beautiful of European cities and to meet colleagues from a wide variety of countries.

Full details of the trip will be available in due course. As flights to Prague tend to be heavily booked, it would be useful to know as soon as possible what size group we shall be looking at.
