The Slovak Theatre Centre and the Department of Stage Design on Academy of Theatre Arts (VŠMU) in Bratislava invite their colleagues - scenographers, pedagogues, theatre artists and theoreticians to an excursion to Bratislava. Those who would like to participate in this excursion can do their registration in the Theatre Institute - Secretariat of the Prague Quadrennial, Celetná 17, Praha 1 - by 10th June at the latest. They will be guests of Slovak colleagues - it means the transport, accommodation and small daily allowance will be covered by Slovak Theatre Centre.

We would like to remind that Bratislava is not far from Vienna (60 km) and the guests can eventually plan their home-trip from Vienna -(to Vienna and to the airport Schwechat is regular bus-connection at 7,00 a.m., 11a.m. and at 5,30p.m., 8,30 p.m. from Bratislava; the price of a busticket is 75 ATM, a taxi approx. 1000 ATM).

The number of participants is limited by the number of seats in bus. In case of your interest inform us, please, as soon as possible.
